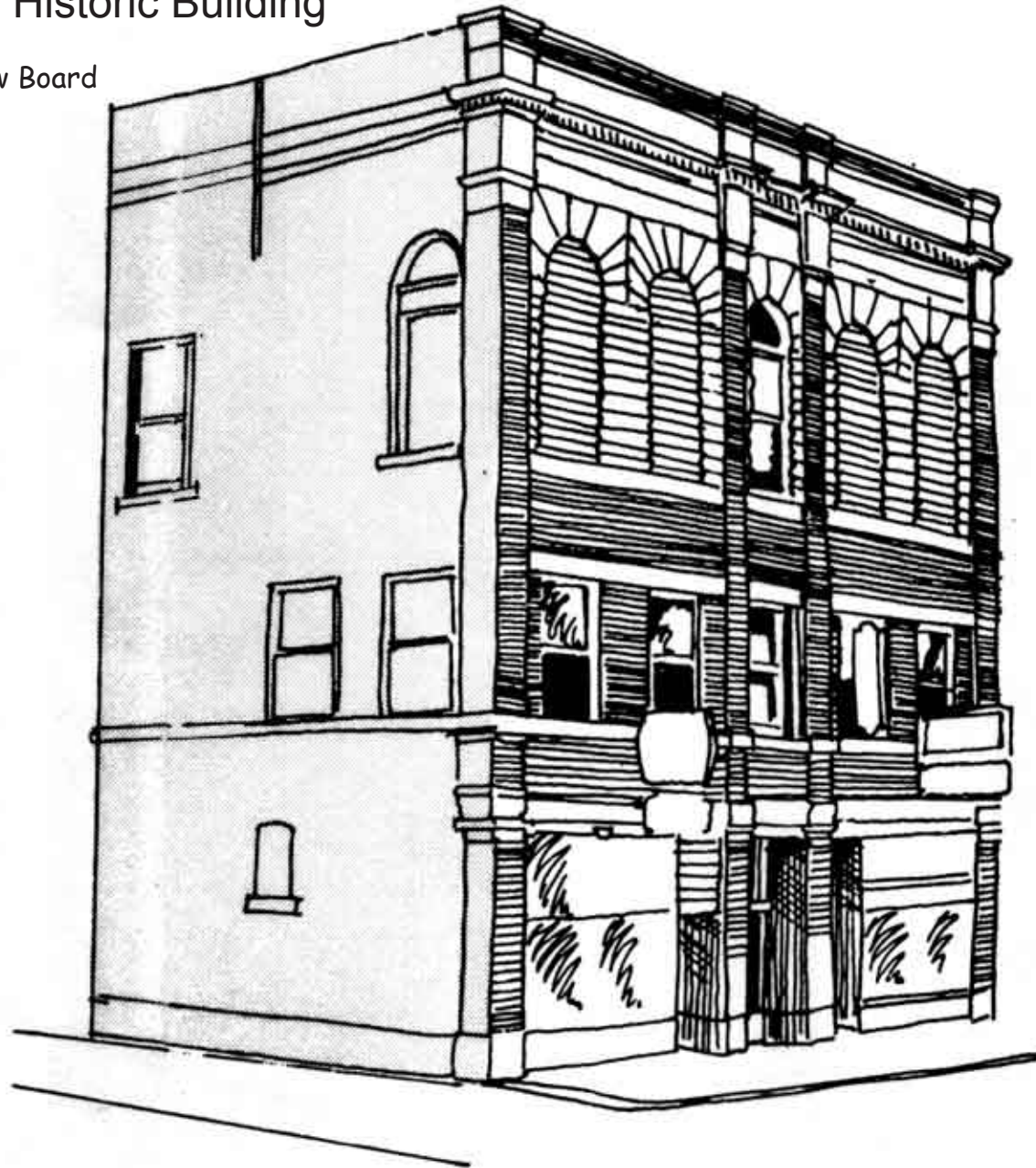

BOOS & PFEIFFER BUILDING -- Built in 1904, of buff brick and limestone, the Boos & Pfeiffer building is a fine example of Classical Revival architecture. The round arched windows on the upper floor are surrounded by limestone voussoirs. The chaste parapet, of brick and limestone, is supported by a refined entablature, containing dentils and corbelled masonry.
