SAMUEL PURVIANCE HOUSE - 326 S. Jefferson Street -- This stately brick Italianate home was built in 1859 by Samuel Hillary Purviance, a businessman and banker who first came to Huntington in 1841. Notable both for its associations with early local history and for its magnificent architectural style, it contains a bracketed cornice with broad eaves, brick quoins, labelled window hoods and an elaborate porch. The interior also retains much of its original integrity.
