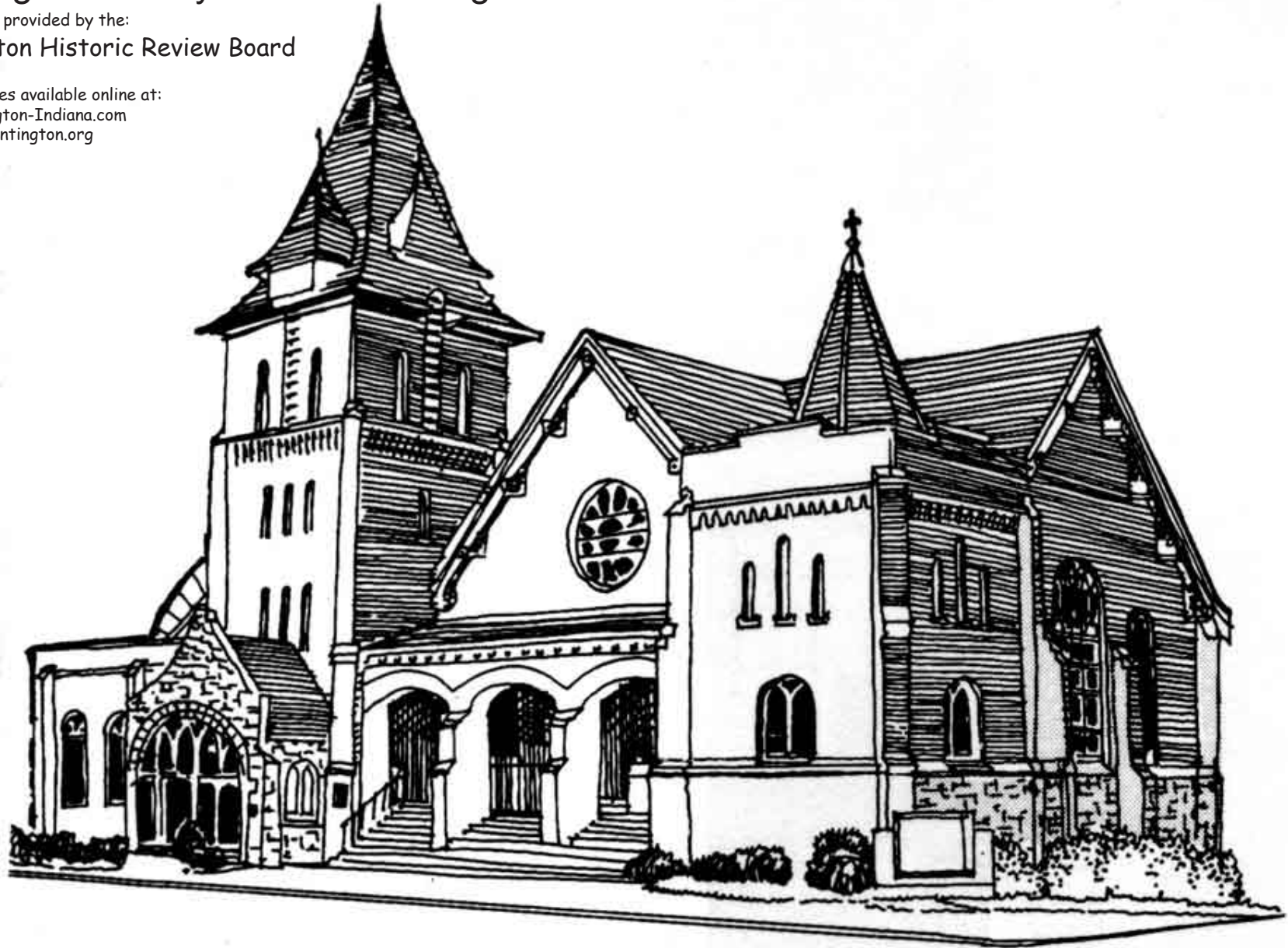


# Huntington County Historic Building

**GERMAN REFORMED CHURCH - 202 Etna Avenue** -- Designed by architect William A. Stevens (a Huntington native who worked in the office of several reknown Chicago architects), this building combines Eastlake, Richardsonian and Tudor elements. Constructed in 1904, it is a good example of turn-of-the-century eclecticism. The structure is located in an area once known as Drover Town, a German settlement which was platted by Henry Drover in 1857 and annexed to the town of Huntington in 1874.
