CITY BUILDING/FIRE STATION -- The 1904 City Building is an excellent example of the Richardsonian Romanesque style, named after the architect H. H. Richardson (1838-1886). The use of high, pointed towers and round arches within the cross gables on the second floor, give the building a soaring gracefulness, yet dignity and power of the massive rock-faced exterior remains. The adjoining fire station, which dates from 1917, is sympathetic to the original structure.
