GELZLEICHTER GROCERY AND UFHEIL BLOCK -- The two story brick building at 616 North Jefferson Street once housed the grocery store of Peter Gelzleichter. Its brick cornice, composed in a dentil and modillion pattern, crowns three elongated windows with segmental arched hoods. The two adjacent buildings to the north, known together as the Ufheil Block, were constructed c. 1870 and have similar, slightly larger facades and central oriel windows.
