THE LEWIS BLOCK -- This building combines numbers 401-403 North Jefferson Street and displays some of the most charming details of the Late Victorian era to be found in the district. Italianate pedimented dormers (on the crowning corner tower) are combined with rock-faced limestone window surrounds and a round arch - typical Romanesque elements. A bracketed cornice serves to unify several of the facade elements on Jefferson Street. First floor cast iron piers and some of the storefront window and bulkhead details are still present.
