OPERA HOUSE -- Live theatrical entertainment was a common occurrence in downtown Huntington from 1881, when the Opera House was opened by a well-known actress. Performances were enjoyed on the second floor of this Italianate structure, while the first floor housed a variety of businesses. Among the many outstanding architectural details of this building are the two towers, each of which have slate-covered, steeply-pitched roofs topped with decorative finials.
