OUR SUNDAY VISITOR -- One of the largest Catholic publishing houses in the world, Our Sunday Visitor was founded by Father John F. Noll. This building was constructed in 1926 and its early twentieth century eclectic style is notable for its Spanish influences. These can be seen in the green mission tiles and decorative cream terra cotta details. The main entrance on West Park Drive is replete with symbols of the various publications, as well as Christian, floral and traditional motifs.
